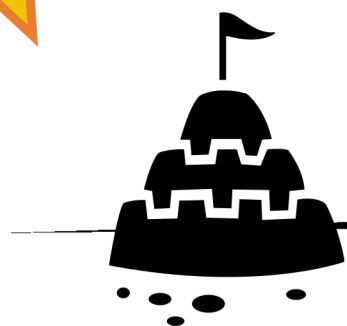
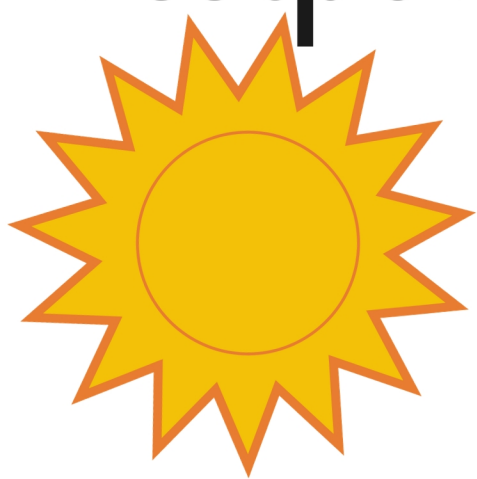


Westport Village Apartments

POKENO

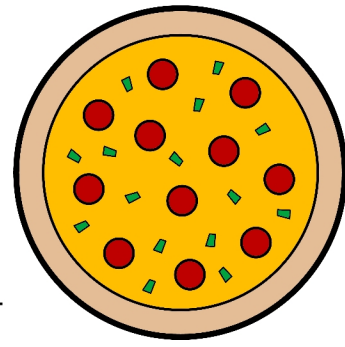
Pokeno is played in the community room every Tuesday at 6 PM

Taking Hold of Money Matters

Tax Day (April 15th) is behind us so now is a good time to look at your finances and make a quick fix if necessary – and there's no time like the present to take that action.

Here are some common mistakes that you can fix quickly and easily.

If you hold any US Savings Bonds, cash those Bonds in at maturity and put the returns in an account that will offer a better return.

Do you have your child as a joint owner on any of your accounts? This privilege gives that individual free access to your funds. If you have any concerns about having your life savings in one account, limit that particular account to hold just enough cash to handle the day-to-day bills and open another account with the excess.

If you are contributing to tax deferred accounts, at 50 or older you can add an extra \$5,500 a year to your account. If you are still working at age 55 just by bumping up your contribution by a small percentage, you can lower your annual tax bill.

Let's take the process a step further. Have you looked at your important documents to see who the beneficiaries are? Make certain that those named as beneficiaries are still valid assigned as primary and secondary recipients.
